HAY MARKET STEADY TO STRONGER TOWARD END OF NOVEMBER Fae Holin, MFA Communication Specialist

The Upper Midwestern hay market is steady to stronger, according to recent auction sale reports and the Nov. 28 <u>Hay</u> <u>Market Demand and Price Report for the Upper Midwest.</u>

Prime (greater than 151 RFV/RFQ) alfalfa large squares sold for \$255/ton; large rounds, \$221/ton; and small squares, \$288/ton, according to the Upper Midwestern report. Grade 1 hay (125-150 RFV/RFQ) averaged \$215/ton for large squares, \$191/ton for large rounds, and \$202/ton for small squares while Grade 2 hay (103-124 RFV/RFQ) averaged \$171/ton for large squares and \$152/ton for large rounds. Grade 3 hay (87-102 RFV/RFQ) large squares and large rounds averaged \$100/ton and \$121/ton, respectively.

Wisconsin

Premium alfalfa large squares priced at \$225/ton at the <u>Nov. 23 Tim Slack Auction & Realty sale</u> at Lancaster. Goodquality alfalfa sold for \$135-170/ton in large squares, \$130-140/ton in large rounds, and \$4-5.25/bale in small squares. Good-quality grass large squares sold for \$140-145/ton, large rounds, \$125/ton; and small squares, \$4/bale.

First-crop alfalfa large squares averaged \$225/ton, while second-crop ranged from \$105 to \$115/ton, and third-crop, \$140 to \$195/ton at the <u>Nov. 19 Reynolds Livestock, LLC auction</u>. Alfalfa second-crop large rounds sold for \$117.50-127.50/ton, first-crop, \$120/ton; and third-crop, \$110/ton. Third-crop alfalfa large squares wrapped sold for \$110/ton. Third-crop alfalfa large rounds wrapped brought \$90-120/ton; fourth-crop wrapped, \$50-105/ton; second-crop wrapped, \$90/ton; and first-crop wrapped, \$40-90/ton. Grassy large rounds averaged \$137.50/ton.

Minnesota

Good-quality alfalfa large rounds priced at \$205/ton, according to the <u>Nov. 28 USDA Market News report</u> of the Nov. 22 Pipestone Hay and Straw Auction. Fair-quality alfalfa large rounds brought \$170-195/ton while utility large rounds sold for \$145-160/ton. Alfalfa-grass large rounds ranged from \$170 to \$175/ton; utility large rounds, \$145/ton. Premium grass large rounds averaged \$170-185/ton, good-quality grass large rounds brought \$150-165/ton, fair-quality large rounds, \$135-145/ton; and utility large rounds, \$80-135/ton. Good-quality oat hay large rounds ranged from \$155 to \$160/ton.

lowa

A "very strong" market, with grass large rounds (stored inside) at their highest price – \$175/ton – since last February, characterized the <u>Nov. 23 Dyersville Sales Co. auction</u>, according to the auction house. Good-quality alfalfa large squares ranged from \$185 to \$240/ton; fair-quality alfalfa large squares, \$155 to 185/ton. Alfalfa large rounds ranged from \$150 to \$175/ton at good quality, \$105 to \$145/ton at fair quality, and \$60 to 100/ton at utility hay, wet. Good-quality grass large rounds ranged from \$70 to \$175/ton. Good-quality mixed hay large squares sold for \$175-240/ton; large rounds, \$150-175/ton.

Second-crop alfalfa large squares ranged from \$135 to \$225/ton; third-crop, \$175 to 195/ton; and first-crop averaged \$215/ton at the <u>Nov. 23 Fort Atkinson Hay auction</u>. Third-crop alfalfa large rounds priced at \$100-155/ton; second-crop, \$100-150/ton; and first-crop, \$60-140/ton. First-crop alfalfa small squares sold for \$195/ton; third-crop, \$175/ton. Grass large rounds ranged from \$120 to \$145/ton.

Supreme alfalfa large squares sold for \$250-260/ton; large rounds, \$250-255/ton at the Nov. 21 Rock Valley Hay Auction, according to <u>USDA's Market News report of Nov. 22</u>. Premium- to supreme-quality alfalfa medium squares averaged \$245/ton and large rounds sold for \$222.50-247.50/ton. Premium alfalfa large rounds sold for \$210-215/ton. Alfalfa-grass premium large rounds averaged \$200/ton, and grass premium large rounds sold for \$220-240/ton. Grass good- to premium-quality large squares averaged \$195/ton; large rounds brought \$197.50-207.50/ton. Grass good-quality large rounds brought \$182.50-195/ton; fair- to good-quality grass large rounds, \$150-155/ton.

Good- to premium-quality alfalfa small squares averaged \$260/ton, according to the <u>Nov. 22 USDA Market News' Iowa</u> <u>Direct Hay Report</u>. Premium alfalfa-grass medium squares averaged \$240/ton. Good-quality mixed grass large rounds averaged \$100/ton.

South Dakota

Premium alfalfa large rounds averaged \$240/ton at the Dakota Hay Auction at Corsica, according to <u>USDA's Nov. 28</u> <u>Market News report</u>. Alfalfa large rounds sold for \$210-230/ton at good quality. Alfalfa-grass premium large rounds averaged \$245/ton; good-quality barley large rounds averaged \$205/ton. Grass premium large rounds ranged from \$190 to \$220/ton; good-quality grass large rounds averaged \$185/ton, and utility large rounds, \$130/ton.

Supreme alfalfa large rounds and premium alfalfa large squares each averaged \$260/ton, according to <u>USDA's Market</u> <u>News' Nov. 17 South Dakota Direct Hay Report</u>. Alfalfa-grass premium large rounds averaged \$230/ton. Grass premium large rounds averaged \$200/ton, good-quality large rounds, \$180/ton.
