

How Do We Get to the Bottom of the Alfalfa Autotoxicity Problem?

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The cost-benefit conundrum of using high-quality alfalfa varieties is highly dependent on the classical trade-off of yield vs quality. It also depends on the specific definition of quality, which may vary depending on target market and production goals. This presentation will outline definitions of quality, factors that affect it, and how those relate to value and production cost. The objective is not to tell you which variety is “best,” but to build your skill set related to making variety-selection decisions that fit your particular operation.



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
